

**Minutes of Special Waddingham Parish Council Meeting**  
**On Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2016 at 7.15pm in the Jubilee Hall**

**Planning**

Application: 134779 - For prior notification to install 1no. 15m high lattice tower with 3 no. antennas, 2 no. dishes, 3 no. equipment cabinets and ancillary development within a chain linked fenced enclosure.

Location: Waddingham House Farm, Snitterby Road, Waddingham, DN21 4RH.

The Chairman, Councillor David Waite had rung the Clerk and declared an interest in the application and gave his apologies for the meeting. The Clerk to minute this and enter in the Interests Book.

The Vice-Chairman James Cousins chaired the special meeting in the absence of the Chairman.

All Members had viewed the application. Cllr C Metcalfe was unable to attend the meeting but had noted that he is 'ambivalent to the application, presenting as it does an opportunity to improve the mobile communications within the village'. The 15m tower is the same height as the current tower and Members agreed that it is out of the way and probably in the best position in the village. Overall, Members have no objections to the application but did comment that this should not set a precedent for businesses to consider requesting similar structures elsewhere within the village. This was unanimously agreed.

The Clerk will notify West Lindsey District Council that the Parish Council has no objections but also include a note regarding setting a precedent.
