Amenities we have that we need to keep;

- Shop/post office
- Church/places of worship
- Pub
- Jubilee hall
- Village green

Amenities that would improve life in Waddingham and Brandy Wharf that may have planning implications;

- Housing to suit different groups e.g. First homes, homes suitable for older people, young families
- Green energy generation
- Broadband connectivity
- Phone coverage
- Children's play park

Other things that need consideration

- Access to doctor and pharmacist
- Transport links
- Flood risk, sewage system, spring in Pub carpark?
- Social housing

Transport Links for businesses – travel to and from work.

Allotments – if 6 parishioners request an allotment then the Parish council is duty bound to provide them.

Creating a community shop if necessary

Rejuvenation of spaces available in Jubilee Hall. E.g. chiropodist, Parish nurse

Do not want Waddingham Parish to become a suburb of Kirton.

Take care of where houses will be to maintain the street scenes.

The only way to increase facilities within the village is to increase the housing stock. Is that what we really want? If so how big should the villages become

The current facilities are actually underused e.g. Jubilee Hall, shop pub, church.

Do we want to protect out small rural village life (aspic)

The plan will be a 20 year time line to address the issues raised.

Do we aim for a population of for example 1000?

Develop small business in the village, Business centre/hub and communication links.
