Dear Ms Wright,

We have just heard that the Local Electricity Bill will be re-introduced and debated in the House of Commons on Wednesday next week (10<sup>th</sup> June), directly after Prime Minister's Questions.

153 MPs (cross-party) support the Bill and it will be introduced by Peter Aldous MP alongside a cross-party group of 11 co-sponsoring MPs. 270 Parish, Town and Community Councils have so far resolved to support the Bill too.

This is an excellent opportunity to encourage more MPs to support the Bill and to encourage the government to seriously consider it.

**Could you please help urgently by**

1. Writing to your MP, asking that they 'Please support the Local Electricity Bill and please attend its House of Commons debate this Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> June', and
2. Asking members of the Council to write too? The more messages MPs receive, the better.

If made law, the Bill would lead to new community-scale clean energy infrastructure which would help to strengthen local economies and communities.
